Bratz Youth Club Is Here!!!



From 5pm till 7pm we open the doors for Brimrod Junior Youth Club for ages 6-12.

Entry is £1 with a tuck shop available during the session.

From 7pm, The Bratz Youth Club starts for ages 13 to 19 year olds. Entry is also charged at £1 with a tuck shop available.

Over the past year, Bratz has been working hard to secure a safe place for the young people of Brimrod to go and hang out and keep safe.

We can now confirm that after much consultation and hard work we now have three youth club sessions up and running.

On Tuesdays, we have two sessions up at Brimrod School starting from the 18th January.

Currently open, On Fridays we have 1 session for the Bratz Junior Youth Club at Matthew Moss Youth Centre, (Located next to Matthew Moss High School)

This session is also charged at £1 with a tuck shop available.

Junior Youth Club - Tuesdays 5 till 7pm at Brimrod School. (6 - 12 yr olds) (£1 entry)

Bratz Youth Club - Tuesdays 7pm till 9pm at Brimrod School (13 - 19 yr olds) (£1 entry)

Junior Youth Club - Fridays 5 till 7pm at Matthew Moss Youth Centre (6 - 12 yr olds) (£1 entry)

We have been listening to residents and tenants in the area and put a lot of time, effort and money in to providing these sessions. Please ensure full use is made of them.
